Transition Year Intake Policy

Transition Year is an option for all Third Year students moving on to Senior Cycle. In February/March each year, students may apply for a place on the Transition Year Programme. The school will admit the number of boys to the Transition Year Programme as determined by the Board as feasible on an annual basis. The Board has decided that 90 places will be allocated in Transition Year each year. Students may be refused a place in Transition Year based on a poor attendance, punctuality or behaviour record. Full payment of Transition Year fees is compulsory to secure a place in Transition Year. If the fee is not paid by the appointed date then the place may be forfeited and offered to the next student on the waiting list. Where the number of eligible applicants exceeds the number of places available, the selection of students is based on a lottery. All students will be notified of the result of the lottery in February/March/April. After that, a numbered Waiting List will be compiled and students will be informed of their place on the Waiting List. Should a place become available, the next student on the Waiting List will be notified.

Appeals should be made in writing to the Board of Management.

Students who have not completed their Junior Cert. in Coláiste Phádraig will only be offered a place in Transition Year if a place is available after the completion of the application and selection process for students who completed their Junior Cert. in Coláiste Phádraig.
